GRANT FOR JUNIOR-LEVEL VISITING PROFESSORSHIP TO THE EXTERIOR

The Project, "The Post-Colonial in the Portuguese-speaking world and the place of African literature in world literature: Globalization and cultural superdiversity." of the thematic area "State and Society within global contemporaneity; dynamics of inequality and development" of the Institutional Program for Internationalization of the Federal University of Pernambuco announces that from 10/06/2020 until 10/26/2020, applications will be received for a grant for a **Junior Level Visiting Professorship in the Exterior.**

1. OBJECTIVES

- 1.1. Implement the Institutional Program for Internationalization (Print) of CAPES in the Federal University of Pernambuco, by alerting those interested to a grant for a Senior Level Visiting Professorship in the Exterior, designated for a UFPE professor or researcher who has held a doctorate degree for more than 10 (ten) years from the date of the start of the grant.
- 1.2. Enable the realization of the grant project according to the objectives described in the international cooperation project, by fulfilling the requirements provided for in the fellowship with the Partner Institutions abroad to which he / she will be linked.

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 The conditions for eligibility for candidates:

2.1.1. Hold a doctorate degree that was obtained more than 10 years ago in a course evaluated by CAPES and recognized by CNE/MEC, or from a course in a foreign institution validated in Brazil; for the purpose of calculating this time, a minimum time since obtaining this degree would be 12 (twelve) years before the month in which the grant is awarded;

2.1.2. Be Brazilian or Permanent Resident with employment links to UFPE;

2.1.3 be a professor at the UFPE, a member of the of the Print Project Group "The Post-Colonial in the Portuguese-speaking world and the place of African literature in world literature: Globalization and cultural superdiversity";

2.1.4 Have his or her curriculum posted on both the Lattes and ORCID platforms;

2.1.5 not be retired on in the process of requesting retirement.





3. GRANT BENEFITS AND NUMBER OF AWARDS

3.1 A Monthly scholarship and benefits according to Capes Ordinances No. 01/2020 and No. 202/2017.

3.2 This specific announcement offers 01 (one) grant for a Senior Visiting Professor in the Exterior Junior, to cover 03 (three) months.

4. PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

4.1 Proposals should be submitted, by e-mail, by the applicant to the Selection Committee of the Project "The postcolonial in the Portuguese-speaking world and the place of African literature in world literature. Members of this committee are Professors Remo Mutzenberg, Josefa Salete Barbosa Cavalcanti and José Luiz de Amorim Ratton. The Proposal should contain the following documents:

4.1.1 Doctoral diploma;

4.1.2 Letter of invitation from the supervisor or host in the foreign institution of destination, including details of training or research activities;

4.1.3 Document attesting that, should the grant be awarded, the grantee has proficiency in the language of the host institution or in a language acceptable by the IES at destination. A letter may be submitted from the IES at destination attesting to f the candidate's capability to undertake the activities proposed (see Appendix XII of Public Announcement n^o 41/2017CAPES);

4.1.4 A Work Plan that shows adherence to the Project / Thematic Area, containing a description of the potential benefits that the post-doctoral internship will represent for the internationalization of the Post-Graduate Program component of the Project, specifying whether this is a new interaction or a continuation of collaboration.

5. ANALYSIS AND CLASSIFICATION OF PROPOSALS

5.1 In the selection process, the Commission responsible will consider the fulfillment of the requirements of this Notice by the Candidate and the completeness of the documentation submitted. The following criteria will be used to classify Applications:

5.1.1 candidate's curriculum;

5.1.2 work plan, considering:

5.1.2.1 relevance of the work plan undertaken in the exterior for the PrInt / UFPE project within the intentions of the thematic area "State and society in the global contemporaneity: dynamics of inequality and development" and its feasibility within the expected timetable;

5.1.2.2 scientific potential for the development of the studies proposed abroad.

6. DISCLOSURE OF RESULTS AND RESOURCES

6.1 The selection committee will announce the results on the PPGS (Postgraduate Program in Sociology) website after the selection, according to the schedule set forth in item 8.

6.2 Requests for reconsideration of results may be submitted to the Selection Committee within two (2) business days after publication of the results;

6.2.1 The Selection Committee shall have two (2) business days to express its opinion on the request for reconsideration.





6.3 Requests for appeals regarding the outcome of the request for reconsideration will be the responsibility of the PrInt Administration Group at UFPE;

6.3.1 Requests must be submitted within two (2) business days to the Management Group at PROPG;

6.3.2 The Steering Committee will publish a final decision within 5 (five) business days.

7. ACCOUNTABILITY

7.1 The Grantee Jr. Scholar will submit a report on returning from internship abroad.
