VIRTUAL EXPERIENCES


Campus b has been offering top-notch international education experiences since 2010. Over 4,000 students from over 80 universities have already been part of our experiential learning programs.


Getting you out of your comfort zone, to expose yourself to new cultures, knowledge, tastes and sounds, so that you can know more about the other and consequently yourself.

Interns will have the opportunity to work alongside students from different nationalities and universities, and experienced professionals in renowned organizations. All interns will be placed within an organization working on actual projects, with a dedicated supervisor and a program coordinator based in Brazil for support during the 6-8 weeks of the program.



PROGRAM OVERVIEW



Start: from January 15th to March 15th **Program length:** from 6-8 weeks



WHAT?

Team-Based Internship projects (4-6 students per team), leadership development in solving cases and mentoring, personal development, virtual cultural learning/immersion.



Online meetings **once or twice a week** with the organization; mentoring sessions for support with the project development; biweekly meetups with the Campus B program coordinators for feedback and support.

SAMPLE PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Virtual Internship

Week 1: Kick-Off & Orientation & Cultural Aspects Portuguese Classes

Week 2-8: - Weekly meetings with Campus b (each group)

- Biweekly 'virtual coffee gathering' (all groups)
 - Talk to Campus B 'board & guests'
- Mentoring sessions with the Academic Advisor
- Internship Wrap-Up, Reflection and Closing

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The program works as a **real internship*** and its workload is divided into weekly meetings with the company, Campus b and activities to do, besides the mentoring sessions and cultural workshops;
- The students must participate to all the interactions synchronously, especially the weekly company meetings (except for emergency situations);
- Groups** are expected to meet separately to work on the project;
- All the participants will receive a certificate issued and signed by Campus b and the company you worked with;
- All the program will run in **English**.

*Internship is a term commonly used to formalize practical experiences in the curriculum of USA Higher Education Institutions (HEI) that validate this program on their resume. The regulation of Brazilian legislation follows Law 11.788 and each HEI establishes its own internal regulation. This program does not provide for the validation of internship hours or credits. Brazilian students need to consult your home HEI to check if the hours can be validated as a complementary or extracurricular activity.

The group assignment will take in consideration your **CV, **preferences**, **availability** and **company comments**, that is why it is not guaranteed you will take your first project choice.


